



Spirit Airlines Continues Dallas/Fort Worth Expansion with International Service to Toluca/Mexico City Plus Service to Detroit, San Diego and Portland, Oregon

Fares from \$38.79 (one way)* Available at Spirit.com
Based on \$9.00 base fare plus taxes and fees*

Miramar, Florida (June 21, 2012) – Spirit Airlines (NASDAQ: SAVE) is continuing its expansion at Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport with service to four more cities. Today Spirit starts its first international flight from DFW with daily nonstop service to Toluca/Mexico City, and also starts daily nonstop service to Detroit, San Diego and Portland, Oregon.

To celebrate, Spirit is offering fares from \$38.79 (one way)*, which is a \$9.00 base fare plus taxes and fees, between Dallas/Fort Worth and Detroit, San Diego and Portland, Oregon, available today and tomorrow at www.spirit.com, and fares from \$65.41 – \$77.78 (one way)*, which is a \$1.00 base fare plus taxes and fees, between Dallas/Fort Worth and Toluca/Mexico City.

Since starting operations at DFW in May of 2011, Spirit has continued to grow its operations and today offers nonstop service to 15 destinations from DFW, including Fort Lauderdale, Las Vegas, Chicago, Atlanta, Boston, New York LaGuardia, Orlando, Phoenix/Mesa, Denver, Myrtle Beach, Tampa, Toluca/Mexico City, Detroit, San Diego and Portland, Oregon.

“We are thrilled that customers from throughout the Metroplex and beyond have embraced Spirit’s ultra low fares. Thanks to their response, we’re proud to continue adding service to even more popular destinations in the U.S. and now Toluca/Mexico City, our first international destination from DFW,” said Dallas native and Spirit’s Chief Marketing Officer Barry Biffle. “We are here to save consumers money on travel and satisfy their need for low fares.”

“Spirit Airlines is clearly gaining a lot of traction in the Dallas/Fort Worth market, with new flights to San Diego, Portland, Detroit and Toluca, Mexico,” said Jeff Fegan, CEO of Dallas Fort Worth International Airport. “The Toluca flight is the 49th international destination being served from DFW. The route has been of great interest to local business travelers and with Toluca being a Sister City to Fort Worth, it already has great support. Spirit’s growth here at DFW has been fast-paced and travelers are benefiting from these greater travel options.”

“Spirit Airlines has been a link that has strengthened the growth of new international routes to Toluca International Airport,” said Dr. Eruviel Avila Villegas, Governor of the State of Mexico. “The citizens of the State of Mexico want their state to continue growing and have a stronger presence around the world. Today we celebrate this benefit to our state because we are going to be connected with one of the most important airports in the world: Dallas/Fort Worth. I’m sure that this important new destination will be very successful, increasing our touristic, economic and brotherhood bonds between the State of Mexico and the United States of America. Congratulations.”

“We are very pleased that Spirit Airlines is adding another nonstop destination to its already impressive array of service options to and from Detroit,” said Tom Naughton, Interim CEO of the Wayne County Airport Authority which operates Detroit Metropolitan Airport. “This is the first low-cost carrier service to Dallas/Fort-Worth from Detroit and will provide another option for our cost-conscious consumers.”

“We are excited that Spirit is inaugurating nonstop flights between San Diego and Dallas/Fort Worth,” said Thella Bowens, President/CEO of the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority. “Spirit is providing another nonstop option for the over 270,000 passengers flying this route annually.”

“We welcome Spirit’s expansion at Portland International Airport,” said David Zielke, Port of Portland General Manager of Air Service Development. “Spirit is a welcome addition at PDX since launching nonstop service to Las Vegas in September, and we expect equal enthusiasm from our community for this new nonstop route to Dallas/Fort Worth.”

Air Travel within the United States

Quoted fare includes the base fare plus any applicable taxes, fees and surcharges. These fares are only available for nonstop flights. The following government taxes and fees apply to your domestic air travel:

- A 7.5% Federal Excise Tax.
- September 11th Security Fee: A September 11th Security Fee of \$2.50 applies per enplanement originating at a U.S. airport up to \$10 per round trip.
- Domestic Segment Tax: A segment tax of \$3.80 per U.S. domestic flight segment (a flight segment is defined as one takeoff and landing).
- Passenger Facility Charges (PFC): Up to \$18 per round trip per customer in local airport charges.

The following carrier fees apply to your domestic air travel:

- Passenger Usage Fee: Passenger Usage Fee of \$16.99 per one way travel per traveling customer applies to most reservations. A lower fee of \$8.99 may apply to certain discount fares. No fee applies to bookings completed at Spirit Airlines' airport locations.
- Unintended Consequences of DOT Regulations Fee: Unintended Consequences of DOT Regulations Fee of \$2.00 per one way travel per traveling customer applies to most reservations. International Air Travel (including Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands)

- Non-U.S. government taxes and fees of up to 19% of total fare.
