Spirit Announces New Service From Detroit to Boston

FORT LAUDERDALE, Fla. (April 27, 2006) – Spirit Airlines announces new, twice daily non-stop service from its Detroit hub to Boston, Spirit’s newest route map addition and 30th destination. Service begins August 15, 2006.

These new flights will be served with new Spirit Airbus A319 aircraft holding 138 passengers with 8 in Spirit Plus Business Class and 130 in comfortable coach class.

“This market is ripe for a lower fare alternative and who better to provide it than Detroit’s hometown, low fare carrier,” said Barry Biffle, Chief Marketing Officer of Spirit Airlines. “Whether you need to take a business trip to New York, DC, Boston, LA or you just want to get away to Florida or the Caribbean, Spirit can take you there in style.”

“We’re very pleased that Spirit is adding new service to Boston, a popular destination from Detroit,” said Lester Robinson, Wayne County Airport Authority CEO. “This announcement demonstrates Spirit’s ongoing commitment to providing low-fare service for Detroit travelers.”

Spirit has been providing service to Detroit for over 15 years. Spirit offers nonstop service to 14 cities out of Detroit Metro. By September 2006, Spirit’s fleet will consist exclusively of all new Airbus aircraft making Spirit the airline with the youngest fleet in the Americas.

Schedule Effective August 15, 2006 is currently available through spiritair.com or through Spirit’s call center and will be accessible through all other distribution systems next week.

Fares

Introductory coach fares between Detroit and Boston start at \$79* each way. Fares must be booked on spiritair.com by May 31, 2006 for Tuesday/Wednesday travel through December 15, 2006. Fares and schedules will be available through other distribution systems next week.

* Fares must be booked on spiritair.com by 11:59 ET May 31, 2006 for travel Tuesdays/ Wednesdays, 8/15/06 through 12/15/06. Fares are for coach class, reflect the spiritair.com discount, and are \$5 less each way than fares offered at Spirit’s call center. Fares are each way based on round-trip purchase and roundtrip travel is required. These fares require a 21-day advance purchase and a 2 night minimum stay. Fares do not include (a) a segment tax of \$3.30 per U.S. domestic flight segment of a passenger’s itinerary; a flight segment is defined as one takeoff and landing; (b) up to \$18 per round trip in local airport charges; and (c) September 11th Security Fee of \$2.50 per enplanement originating at a U.S. airport, up to \$5 per one way or \$10 per round trip. International fares do not include Government taxes and fees up to \$125 per round trip. Fares are subject to availability and may not be available on all flights on all days. Certain restrictions apply. For best results, please book early.
